Since 2012 **50** families have attended the annual **Children with Diabetes® Friends for Life®** Conference through our support for the **Diabetes Scholars Foundation**. This meeting gives children with type 1 diabetes and their families a place where they can learn from and interact with experts and families just like theirs!

At diabetes camps around the country:

\$1K Donated to the **American Diabetes Association's** Campership fund for every year since introducing the world's first commercial insulin in 1923.

\$94K Donated in 2017.

\$791K Total donated to diabetes camps since 2008.

A three-year survey conducted by the ADA found that camps increased confidence and lowered diabetes-related stress in some campers.¹

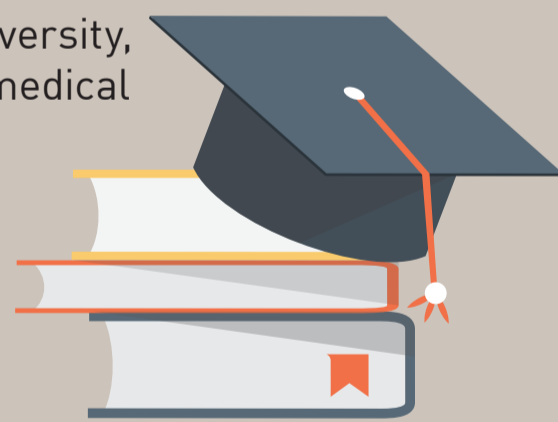
Continues when young adults leave home...
